

~~2005-2006~~ 2006-2007 SOUTH TEXAS PINTO GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Rules effective date and implementation:** These rules and regulations are to be reviewed yearly. The rules and regulations must be voted upon, approved and distributed prior to the distribution of the first show flyer for the first show each year, or as each member joins or renews membership. A copy of these rules and regulations will be available at every show.
2. **Membership and ownership requirements:**
 - A. Membership: Members agree to abide by South Texas Pintos rules and regulations when accepted as a member and pay an annual membership fee. Yearly memberships expire December 31 each year.
 - B. In order to receive club point's horse must be registered in compliance with one of the following two types of memberships:
 1. Individual membership: includes one individual
 2. Immediate family membership: this includes husband, wife, legal and unmarried minor children if horses registered differently to various family member (husband, wife, legal guardian or unmarried minor child) separate memberships are not required. If any horse is registered in the name of children that are married and are no longer minor, they cannot receive points on their horses as part of their parent's family. The age of a minor child is 18 years or younger.
3. **Club Points:** Club points will be recorded in the name of the registered owner or duly recorded lessee as listed on the papers at the time being shown. Points will stop and restart with new owner/club member on any entry tracked as one horse/rider combination. Points tracked on horse only will continue under the following conditions:
 - A. If a member purchases a horse from a non-member, the member must either:
 1. Transfer the ownership of the horse to the members name
 2. Obtain a letter of ownership from the registry
 3. Purchase a membership in the name of the non-member
 - B. If a non-member purchases a horse from a member, the non-member must join the club on or before the effective date of the official transfer of ownership during or before the first show in which the horse exhibits.
 - C. Amateur and Youth exhibitors and horse owners must be club members.
4. **Show Awards and procedures:** A quorum of the board of directors will determine and/or approve award categories. Kind or type of awards and the minimum requirements to win awards based on the individual circumstance of the show. All points earned will be tallied. The minimum requirements as determined by the board of directors will be posted.
5. **Terms and definitions:**
 - A. *Entry is defined as:
 1. PtHA horse, pony, miniature – animal only
 2. PtHA youth, amateur, novice – one horse/one rider, ~~(except lead line and walk trot)~~
 - B. **Sponsored Show: A show solely managed and financed by the club which the club receives the profit.
 - C. ~~**Approved Show: A show sponsored by an organization, club or persons other than STP, which our club has approved for our members to receive points.~~
6. **Daily show high point categories:** Halter/color is not required, but will count toward high point.
 - A. Youth, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Open English, Open Western. Minimum requirements of four (4) classes, three (3) of which must be performance classes.
 - B. YA Walk-Trot (11 & Under), Pony, Breed Stock, ~~and~~ Miniature, Novice Horse and Novice Rider. Must show to 50% of the classes offered.
 - C. ~~Silver Spur Award – Must be 40 years of age or older. Must enter at time of registration. All classes entered will count toward daily high point – one horse/one rider.~~
7. **Pinto Year-End award requirement:** All points earned will count toward year-end awards provide all other club requirements are met. In case of a tie, all individuals will receive duplicate awards. ~~Any show** sponsored or approved by STP will count as qualifying show for year-end requirements.~~ In order for and *entry to qualify for a year end class or category award, the *entry must:
 - A. Be a current South Texas Pinto (STP) member
 - B. Show to a minimum of ~~12-110~~ 110 judges.

- C. Weanlings must show to 79 judges (~~only July, Sept & Oct shows qualify~~ club points will not start until the July show). Work at least 10 hours during the show season or pay \$50 in lieu of work hours. Fee must be paid no later than July ~~21~~57, 20056.
- D. Qualify (earn a minimum of 10 points in class) in at least 50 percent of the classes in category to qualify for category awards.
- E. Work at least 10 hours during the show season or pay \$50 in lieu of work hours. Fee must be paid no later than April ~~28~~24, 20065

8. Pinto Year End – Award Categories:

YOUTH (13 & UNDER & 14-18), AND AMATEUR

- A. **In Hand:** Halter, Western Showmanship, English Showmanship
- B. **Western:** Western Pleasure, Stock Seat Equitation, Disciplined Rail, Ideal Pinto, ~~Stock Seat Bareback Equitation,~~ Trail (western attire)
- C. **English:** English Pleasure, English Equitation, Disciplined Rail, Ideal Pinto, ~~English Bareback Equitation,~~ Trail (English attire).
- D. Walk-Trot 11 & under: Appropriate Halter & Showmanship, Pleasure and Equitation

OPEN

- A. English: English Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, Disciplined Rail, Ideal Pinto, Trail (English attire), ~~Hunter Hack~~
- B. Western: Jr. or Sr. Western Pleasure, ~~Mare or Stallion Western Pleasure,~~ Disciplined Rail, Ideal Pinto, Trail (western attire), ~~Reining~~
- C. Breedstock: Halter, English Pleasure, Disciplined Rail, Trail, Western Pleasure
- D. Pony & Miniature: Halter, Color, Trail-in-Hand, Jumping-in-Hand, Pleasure Driving, Obstacle Driving.
- E. Amateur Novice: Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Trail, Western Pleasure, Stock Seat Equitation
- F. Novice Horse: English Pleasure, English Equitation, Trail, Western Pleasure, Stock Seat Equitation
- G. Novice Rider: English Pleasure, English Equitation, Trail, Western Pleasure, Stock Seat Equitation

Novice Rider Definition: 1st year Rider

SUPER HORSE

~~Overall Point Earner: Tabulated on horse, all points earned in all categories.~~

YOUTH 14-18 SCHOLARSHIP YEAR END AWARD – Will be offered to the Year End High Point 14-18 Youth. A Youth may not win the scholarship in consecutive years. All year end requirements as stated in rule number 7 must be met to receive the award. Award Monies will be given upon proof of college entrance.

SUPREME HALTER HORSE

Overall point earner in the halter competition.

STP Fiesta Supreme Miniature Award

9. Point System: The following point system will be used to award points for high point and year end awards:

B. Grand and Reserve Champions:

1. The grand champion at halter will receive two (2) more points than the highest point earner in its champion sex group excluding the reserve champion.
2. The reserve champion at halter will receive one (1) more point than the highest point earner in its champion sex group, excluding the grand champion.

C. Champion of Champion:

1. Halter: Will receive one more point than any other champion at Halter.
2. Color: Will receive one more point than any other champion at Color.
