Show and Ground Rules:

- Entry into this show constitutes an agreement and an understanding that the South Texas Pinto Club and the Pinto Horse Association of America, Inc. will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or injury that occurred at this show.
- Classes must be added at least two classes prior. No refunds will be given for scratched or missed classes.
- All questions or disputes pertaining to the show must be directed to the show manager.
- Show management will concurrently run PtHA, Utility, and PBHA classes of the same category when possible.
- Jackpot and Specialty classes are not eligible for High Point Awards.
- Pinto High Point will be tallied on a one-horse/rider basis for YA and AM for both the show and year-end awards. Open, mini, and pony will be calculated on the horse/handler. Must show a minimum of 5 classes, one of which must be a halter class.
- All Breed High Point will be tallied on a one-horse/rider basis. Must show a minimum of 5 classes, one of which must be a halter class.
- Walk/Trot class entries cannot enter any other classes that require a lope (AB or PtHA).
- Grand/Reserve will be selected from the first and second-place horses in each age/sex/type category.
- Champion of Champions will be selected from the grand champion of each category, including breed stock. (Not included in High Point, Circuit, and Year-End points)
- Circuit Award: The spring circuit consists of April and May shows. The fall circuit consists of September and October shows. To be eligible owners of pinto horses and all other exhibitors must be a current members of STP for this show to count toward a circuit award. You must show in at least 5 of the same classes per show in a circuit to be eligible for a circuit award.
- All Breed Year-End Awards: Exhibitors must show a minimum of 3 out of 4 judges, must work a total of 10 hours within all four shows or pay \$50 in lieu of work hours, and have a current membership no later than the date of our second show of the show year. **STP points will not be retroactive if membership is paid after the first show.**
- Pinto Year End Awards (STP): Exhibitors must show a minimum of 3 out of 4 judges, must work a total of 10 hours within all four shows or pay \$50 in lieu of work hours, and must have a current membership no later than the date of our second show of the show year. **STP points will not be retroactive if membership is paid after the first show.**
- Per Texas State Law, proof of current negative EIA (Coggins) will be required for all horses, except suckling foals, prior to entry into show or admittance to grounds.
- Current PtHA rules will be followed, patterns not covered under the rules will be posted near the entry gate at least one hour prior to the class.
- You must be 19 years or older to show a stallion.
- In arena assistance will result in disqualification.
- Returned checks will result in a \$100 service fee. Individual awards(s) will be held until outstanding balances are paid.
- All dogs must be kept on a controlled leash. No dogs are permitted inside the chain link fence, spectator area of the arena, or the arena it self. Dogs causing a disturbance will be required to leave the ground
- No unauthorized personnel will be allowed in the show office.
- Anyone causing a disturbance in or around the arena and barn will be asked to leave.
