Show and Ground Rules:

Entry into this show constitutes an agreement and an understanding that the South Texas Pinto Club and the Pinto Horse Association of America, Inc. will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or injury occurring at this show.

- 1. Books close the first 5 classes 15 minutes before show start time.
- 2. Classes must be added at least two classes prior. No refunds will be given for scratched or missed classes.
- 3. All questions or disputes pertaining to the show must be directed to the show manager.
- 4. Show management will combine classes with less than 3 entries whenever possible.
- 5. Individuals(owner/lessee) with multiple horses in show will only be charged an office fee for the first two horses.
- 6. Pinto High Point will be tallied on a one horse/rider basis for YA and AM for both the show and year end awards. Open, Mini, & pony will be tallied on the horse. Must show a minimum of 5 classes, 1 of which must be Halter.
- 7. All Breed High Point will be tallied on a one horse/rider basis. Must show a minimum of 5 classes, 1 of which must must be halter
- 8. All Breed Walk/Trot class entries CANNOT enter any other classes that requires a lope(AB or PtHA).
- 9. Grand/Reserve will be selected from the 1st and 2nd place horses in each age/sex/type category.
- 10. Champion of Champions will be selected from the grand champions of each category, including breedstock.
- 11. Circuit Award : Spring Circuit consists of April and May Shows. Fall Circuit consists of September and October Shows. To be eligible owners of Pinto horses and all other exhibitors must be a current member of STP for this show to count toward Circuit Award. You must show in at least 5 of the same classes per show in both shows in a circuit to be eligible for Circuit Award
- 12. All Breed Year End Awards: Exhibitors must show a minimum 3 out of 4 judges, must be a current member. Must work a total of 10 hours or pay \$55 In lieu of work hours no later than the date of our second show of the show year.
- STP Pinto Year End Awards: To be eligible owners of Pinto horses and all other exhibitors must be a current member of STP for this show to count toward year end awards, must show a minimum of 6 judges out of 8 and work a total of 10 hours or pay \$55 in lieu of work hours no later than the date of our second show of the show year.
- 14. Per Texas State law, proof of current negative EIA (coggins) will be required for all horses, except suckling foals, prior to entry into show or admittance to grounds.
- 15. Current PtHA rules will be followed, patterns not covered under PtHA rules will be posted near the entry gate at least one hour prior to class.
- 16. You must be 19 & over to show a stallion.
- 17. In arena assistance will result in disqualifications.
- 18. Returned checks will result in a \$100.00 service fee. STP Club Year End Awards will be held until restitution is made.
- 19. All dogs must be kept on a controlled leash and no dogs are allowed in the horse staging area or the fenced in area surrounding the arena. This rule will be enforced by the City Of Seguin. Dogs causing a disturbance will be required to leave the grounds.
- 20. No unauthorized personel will be allowed in the show office.21. Anyone causing a disturbance in or around the arena and barn will be asked to leave.
